

- National policies and measures or group of measures
- National projections of anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions
- National systems for policies and measures and projections
- National climate change adaptation planning and strategies

## 31 July


- Approximated greenhouse gas inventories
- Use of ETS auctioning revenues

## 30 September


- Information on support to developing countries

Able to submit final data or reports.




## Supporting Reporter(s)

Managed by the Lead Reporter(s).




